Want to Save Some Lives???

Hello Fellow South Carthay Residents!

A major storm in Southern California in August, a 5.1 earthquake located in Ventura County at the same time. As one spokesman for the L.A. Emergency Response Unit said, "Welcome to Los Angeles, America's disaster theme park."

I wanted to let you know that the South Carthay Emergency Response Team is prepared to respond during a major emergency like a quake that affects all of us. Our Association, the SCNA, has supported us by earmarking several thousand dollars for us to purchase medical supplies and other materials which would be used by the team. We are currently made up of 11 L.A. Fire Department trained members who have gone through more than 17 hours' training and by another 15 South Carthay resident volunteers who we have trained to be our ears and eyes and to respond when needed.

What can you expect from our team in an emergency?

We will be out there gathering information about the status of you our neighbors and your structures so we can

forward that information on to First Responders. We will be setting up a medical response and triage area to meet the needs of those who have been injured, and if possible, to transport the most serious victims to local hospitals. We practice on a quarterly basis to be prepared. Our next exercise will be this coming January. You are encouraged to drop by and observe our command center located at 1160 La Jolla, or our medical response area at the intersection of La Jolla and Orlando at that time.

What can you do to help?

First, and most important, get your home and family prepared. Have enough food and water to last a minimum of 3 days. (Check out the Resources page of the SCNA website www.southcarthay.org and look for links about the ERT for more information.)

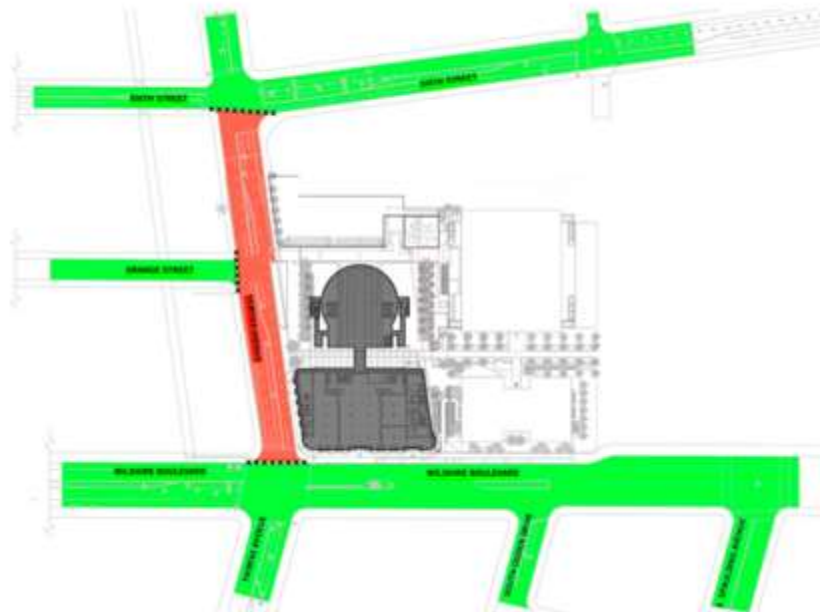
Become a volunteer in our group. It will take about an hour of informal training and then about 8 hours a year of meetings and/or exercises. You can make a difference!

Street Closure This Weekend - Fairfax Avenue

FROM ACADEMY MUSEUM:

***"NOTICE TO OUR NEIGHBORS - TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF FAIRFAX AVENUE
FROM WILSHIRE BOULEVARD TO 6TH STREET ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 14TH OVERVIEW***

Fairfax Avenue (from Wilshire Boulevard to 6th Street) will be closed to vehicular traffic, northbound and southbound.

Closure Hours: 12:00 PM – 11:59 PM

Event Hours: 5:30 PM – 10:00 PM

WEST OF FAIRFAX – RESIDENTS & PEDESTRIANS

- Residents who live on Orange Street between South Crescent Heights Boulevard and Fairfax Avenue will access Orange Street from South Crescent Heights Boulevard.
- The west sidewalk on Fairfax Avenue between Wilshire Boulevard and 6th Street will be open and accessible for pedestrian access.

SOUTH OF WILSHIRE - RESIDENTS

For residents who live south of Wilshire Boulevard, access to 8th Street will not be restricted.

SIGNAGE / CMS BOARDS

To inform drivers of the upcoming closure, DOT-approved signage will indicate the soft closures at the following locations:

- 3rd Street & Fairfax Avenue
- San Vicente Boulevard & Fairfax Avenue
- Wilshire Boulevard & South Crescent Heights
- Fairfax Avenue (east side) & 8th Street

o Please note that 8th Street & Fairfax Avenue signage will indicate "Local Traffic Only" intended for local residents.

Additionally, Traffic Control Officers and museum representatives will be placed at key intersections in the area for safety of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
